Update on the use of the funds donated to the D9600 Disaster Relief fund for the Queensland Floods Recovery

This is how the money was distributed:

- International House, which had a lot of water from the flood, was given \$24,000 for refurbishing rooms.
- Dayboro Little Athletics was given \$6,000 for equipment lost.
- RC Kingaroy was given \$6,000 for restoration of driveways, a flood project of theirs.
- The McIntyre Centre, (Disabled Children riding school) was given \$25,000 through the Brisbane West Daybreak RC.
- The remaining \$70,000 was held back for Mental Health forums etc assoc with Flood damage etc.
