Presenter

Rotarian Greg Burnett gave a Job Talk – one week early. He provided the following script.

- *I am 44 years of age and grew up in Newcastle but moved to Brisbane in 1990 for work and have remained living in Brisbane ever since. My wife Jackie and I have been married for 14 years and we have three children, Rhys 8yrs, Timmy 6yrs and Meghan 3yrs. In my spare time I enjoy fishing and going on family adventures.*
- *Professionally I started my career working with McDonald's, progressing from burger cook through to middle management in the Franchising Division. After a decade with McDonald's I ventured out on my own and*

before returning to corporate roles with Coles Myer in their Supermarkets Division, and then moving across to Telstra Corporation where I have held several different roles for the past six years, and I am currently involved in the retail store development activity which includes the transformation of all company-owned and Licensed store to Telstra's new T(life) retail format, in addition to expanding Telstra's retail foot print by a further 100 stores over the next two years.

- *In addition to my corporate responsibilities, my wife and I operate Internet Only which encompasses a network of company-owned and Licensed coin-operated self-service internet kiosks predominantly within major shopping centres across Australia. Currently there are 35 Internet Only kiosk locations nationally and we are continuing to expand the Internet Only network as new viable opportunities are presented to us. With an increasing consumer shift towards mobile devices such as iPads and other web-enable tablets, Internet Only is working with another Queensland-based company to develop world-first software and technology to provide a full-service high-speed WiFi internet service for shopping centre and hospitality environments and other public spaces, which we aim to export this cutting-edge wireless internet access solution.*

- *My first dealing with Rotary was in 1987 in Newcastle when I was the recipient of a Rotary Pride of Workmanship Award through the Newcastle Rotary Club with my employer at that time a dedicate Rotary Member.*
